## About the project



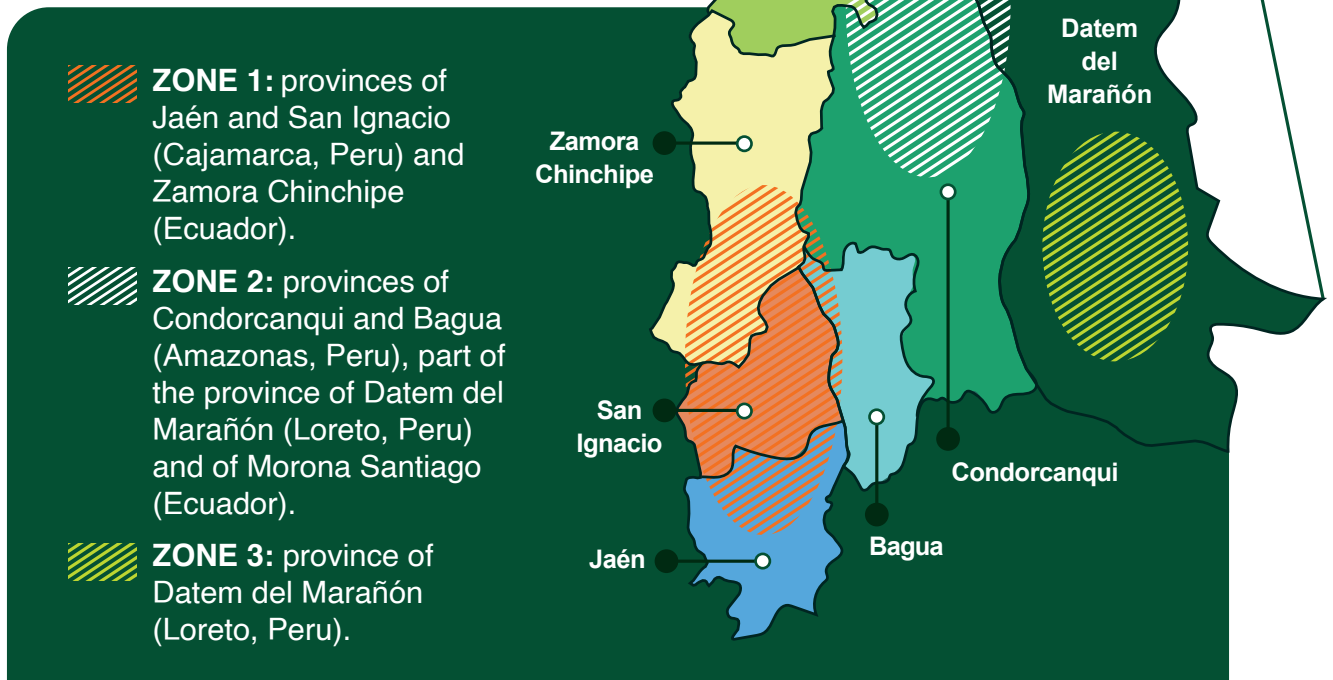
The **Andes Amazon Landscape** is a transboundary territory between **Peru and Ecuador** of great biodiversity and cultural richness.



The project seeks to contribute to the transformation of current systems in the landscape, making strategic interventions in biodiversity conservation, governance, gender, climate finance, and strengthening value chains in order to promote sustainable livelihoods, halt deforestation and biodiversity loss, and promote climate change adaptation and mitigation.

## Andes Amazon Landscape:

- More than 8 millions of hectares of primary tropical forests.
- 6 groups of indigenous people in Peru (Wampis, Awajún, Achuar, Kandozi, Shapra, Kichwa).
- 2 groups of indigenous people and nationalities in Ecuador (Achuar y Shuar).



## Strategic intervention lines:



Strengthening the conservation of biodiversity, connectivity and territories of life.



Strengthening of indigenous landscape organizations for the protection of their rights and governance of their territories.



Strengthening the competitiveness and sustainability of coffee, cacao, banana and bio-business value chains in the landscape.



Implementation: December, 2023 to November, 2029

Inception phase: December 1st, 2023 to June 15th, 2024
